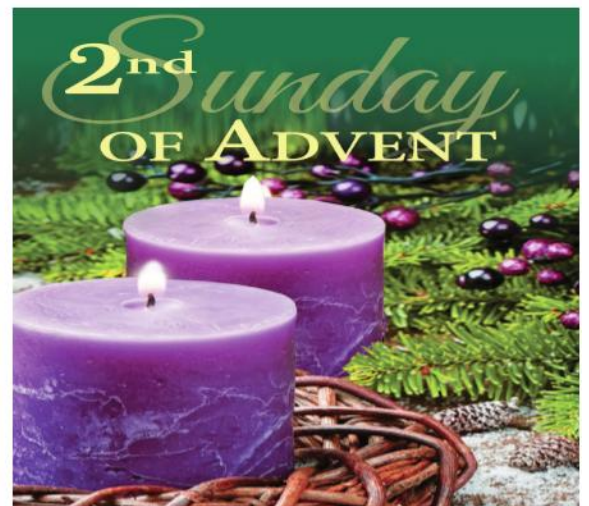

GOSPEL MEDITATION:

What a beautiful joy on this day, to celebrate the second Sunday of Advent and at the same time the Immaculate Conception of Mary. The Lord is coming to save all nations, and boy, do we need Him with so much war and devastation of entire cities. St. John the Baptist is a leading character of Advent and invites us to prepare the way, to make the paths straight. To fill the potholes in our lives, to remove the roughness that hinders us from obtaining salvation. He invites us to receive Christ with our hands full of good fruits. Choosing the best is an art, and if we know how to choose the best gifts for the people we love, we will have to know that the best gift is to receive Jesus in our hearts.

Mary teaches us how to listen to God and wait with confidence and hope. Pope St. John Paul II invited everyone to come to the Immaculate Heart of Mary at all times. Today's entrance antiphon tells us, "I rejoice in the Lord with all my soul, and I am filled with joy in my God, because he has clothed me with garments of salvation, and has covered me with a robe of righteousness, like a bride adorned with her jewels" (Isaiah 61:10). How are you preparing to receive Jesus? What special place do you have at home to pray? Advent is a special time for spiritual growth, so we must be sensitive to the small details that God makes available to us in this special time.

MEDITACIÓN EVANGÉLICA:

Elegir lo mejor es un arte, y si sabemos escoger los mejores regalos para las personas que amamos, tendremos que saber que el mejor regalo es recibir a Jesús en nuestro corazón.

María nos enseña cómo escuchar a Dios y esperar con confianza y esperanza. El Papa San Juan Pablo II invitaba a todos a acudir al corazón inmaculado de María en todo momento. La antífona de entrada de hoy nos dice: "Me alegro en el Señor con toda el alma y me lleno de júbilo en mi Dios, porque me revistió con vestiduras de salvación y me cubrió con un manto de justicia, como la novia que se adorna con sus joyas" (Isaías 61:10). ¿Cómo te estás preparando para recibir a Jesús? ¿Qué lugar especial tienes en casa para hacer oración? El Adviento es un tiempo especial para un crecimiento espiritual, a ser sensibles a los detalles pequeños que Dios pone a nuestro alcance en este tiempo tan especial.
